

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5248

A BY-LAW to assign a name to certain highways
within the municipality.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET NAMING
BY-LAW NO. 2, 1967".
2. The highway presently known as Grandview-Douglas Highway
shall hereinafter be known as Canada Way.
3. The highway between Boundary Road and Sumner Avenue
presently known as Clydesdale Street shall hereinafter be known as
Grandview Highway.
4. The highways more particularly hereinafter described are
hereby assigned the names hereunder:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
RIDLEY DRIVE	First Street South of Curtis Street West from Duthie Avenue.
CHRISTOPHER CRESCENT	First Street West of Smith Avenue South from Burke Street.

5. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the 1st
day of January, 1968 and after a certified copy hereof is filed in
the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, Province of
British Columbia.
