

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5268

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby  
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 21, 1967".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as a Portion of Lot Nine (9), Block Seven (7) of Lot Ninety-Seven (97), Group 1, Plan 1522, New Westminster District, more particularly known and described as follows:

Commencing at a point lying on the Westerly boundary of said Lot 9 and distant 18.00 feet Southwardly from the Northwesterly corner thereof;

Thence N. 0°09'30" E. and following the Westerly boundary of Lot 9, aforesaid, 18.00 feet to the Northwesterly corner thereof;

Thence S.64°20'40" E. and following the Northeasterly boundary of said Lot 9, 18.00 feet to a point;

Thence S.57°54'25" W., 19.21 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 146 square feet, be the same, more or less, as shown outlined in red on Reference Plan prepared by Lothar T. Schwendtmayer, B.C.L.S., sworn the 16th day of November, 1967, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province

of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
