## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BY-LAW NO. 5452

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISI\_
TION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 12, 1968".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and being a portion of District Lot One hundred twenty-four (124), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Plan 13230, which said portion may be more particularly described as follows:

> Commencing at the North-west corner of said part of said District Lot 124; thence S 88° 44' 30" E and following the northerly boundary of said part of said District Lot 124 456.53 feet; thence on a tangential circular curve to the right, having a radius of 354.42 feet, 228.28 feet; thence N 88° 44' 30" W, 72.08 feet; thence N 84° 15' 20" W, 140.62 feet; thence N 88° 44' 30" W 361.09 feet; thence S 69° 58'10" W, 66.10 feet; thence S 0° 17' 30" W, 16.00 feet, more or less, to a point on the southerly boundary of said part of said District Lot 124; thence westerly and following the said southerly boundary, 33.0 feet, more or less, to the south west corner of said part of said District Lot 124; thence northerly and following the westerly boundary of said part of District Lot 124, 100.02 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement, and containing 1.047 acres, more or less, as shown outlined in red on plan prepared by Gordon E. McLaren, B.C.L.S., dated the 7th day of May, 1968, / a copy of which is attached hereto.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said land shall be established as a public highway.
