## BY-LAW NO. 5491

## A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1969".

2. By-Law No. 5412 being, "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 11, 1968", is hereby repealed.

3. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof, by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as follows:

(a) A portion of Lot Fifty-one (51) of District Lot
Four (4), Group One (1), Plan 31308, New Westminster District, which
said portion may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south easterly corner of said Lot 51; Thence N. 89° 31' 00" W., 10 feet; Thence N. 44° 51' 19" E., 13.99 feet; Thence S. 0° 44' 00" E., 10 feet, more or less to the point of commencement and containing 50 square feet;

(b) A portion of Lot Fifty-three (53) of District LotFour (4), Group One (1), Plan 31308, New Westminster District,which said portion may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeasterly corner of said Lot 53; Thence N. 89° 31' 00" W., 10 feet; Thence S. 45° 08' 30" E.,14.29 feet; Thence N. 0° 44' 00" W., 10 feet more or less to the point of commencement and containing 50 square feet; all as shown outlined in red on reference plan prepared by G.C. Emerson, B.C.L.S., dated the 10th day of December, 1968, a copy of which is attached hereto.

4. Upon registration of the said deeds in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
