## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5495

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4299, being the "Burnaby Street and Traffic By-Law 1961".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 1961, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1969".
- 2. Clause (a) of subsection (2) of section 13 of By-Law No. 4299, as enacted by By-Law No. 4760, is repealed.
- 3. Clause (d) of subsection (2) of section 13 of By-Law No. 4299, as enacted by By-Law No. 4760, is repealed and the following substituted therefore:-
  - "(d) No person shall stop or stand a vehicle in front of, or within 10 feet of the nearside of or 5 feet of the farside of, a private road or sidewalk crossing or the street line of any intersecting lane."
