

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5502

A BY-LAW to Acquire Certain Lands for Highway Purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1969".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, ALL AND SINGULAR those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as Lot Four (4) of Lot Five (5) of Lots "F", "G", and "H", Block Seven (7), District Lot One hundred twenty-five (125), Plan 9666, Group One (1), New Westminster District and which may be described more particularly as follows:

All that portion of the said Lot 4 bounded easterly by the easterly boundary of the said District Lot 125, and

bounded westerly by a line parallel to, and 33.00 feet perpendicularly distant from the easterly boundary of the said District Lot 125.

The herein-described portion contains by calculation 0.193 acre, be the same more or less as shown outlined in red on Reference Plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., and sworn to by him on the 3rd day of April, 1969, a copy of which said plan is attached hereto.

The bearings used herein are astronomic and are referred to the meridian of the above-mentioned Reference Plan.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the

Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
