

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5528

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4742, being the
"Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965".

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to amend
"Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965" as hereinafter set forth.

AND WHEREAS Council has held a public hearing thereon
after duly giving notice of the time and place of such hearing.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ZONING BY-LAW
1965, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 31, 1969".

2. Section 101.1(1) of By-Law No. 4742 is repealed and
the following substituted therefor:

"101.1(1) Single family dwellings. Where the lot area exceeds
24,000 square feet, there may be two separate dwellings
on one lot, provided that each dwelling shall and can
be sited as required by the Subdivision Approving
Officer in order to facilitate the future subdivision
of the parcel or adjacent parcels of land."

June, 1969.
