BY-LAW NO. 5536

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a  
Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on plan annexed hereto was established as highway by that certain plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, under number

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 4, 1969".
2. That portion of road (hereinafter called the "said portion"), being all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being a portion (formerly lane) of the Northeast Quarter of Lot One hundred forty-nine (149), Group One (1), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Explanatory Plan 13193, deposited, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwesterly corner of the portion (formerly lane) of Lot 149, Group 1, aforesaid, said point being the Northeasterly corner of Lot 3, according to Plan 22302, deposited;

Thence Southwardly and following a portion of the Westerly boundary of the said portion (formerly lane), 138.63 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the Eastwardly prolongation of the Southerly boundary of Lot 1, according to Plan 19538, deposited;

Thence Eastwardly and following the Eastwardly prolongation of the Southerly boundary of said Lot 1, 10.00 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the Easterly boundary of the portion (formerly lane) aforesaid;

Thence Northwardly and following a portion of the Easterly boundary of the said portion (formerly lane) 138.63 feet, more or less, to the Northeasterly corner thereof;

Thence Westwardly and following the Northerly boundary of the portion (formerly lane) aforesaid, 10.00 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing by estimation 0.0318 of an acre be the same, more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in Red Colour;

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portion and vest title thereto in The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

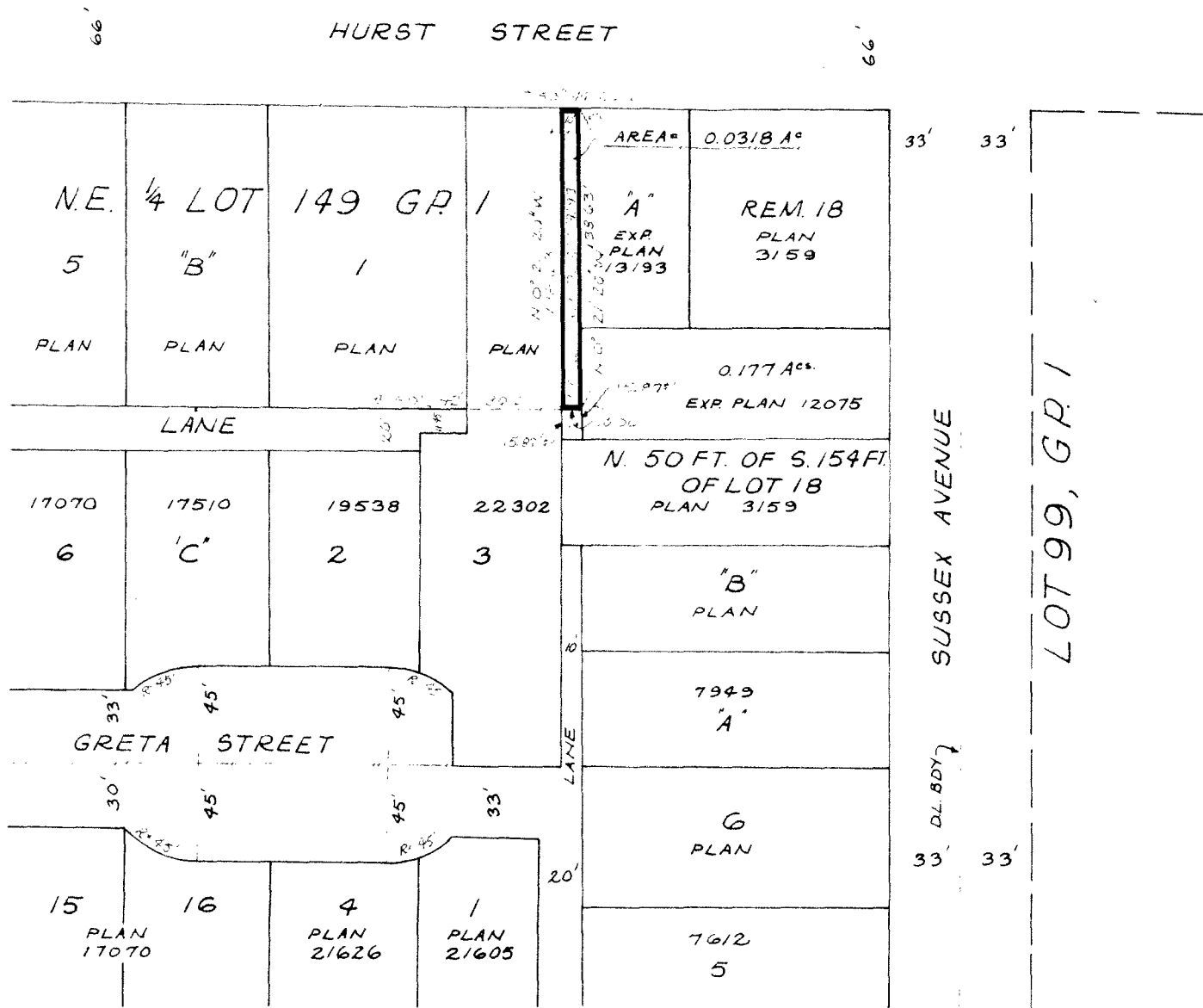
