THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5590

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on Plan annexed hereto was established as highway by that certain plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, under number 3046.

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 11, 1969".
- That portion of road (hereinafter called the "said portion"), being all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described a portion, formerly Monroe Avenue, of District Lot Thirteen (13), Group One (1), New Westminster District, which said portion may be more particularly known and described as follows:

Firstly: All that portion of the said Monroe Avenue lying adjacent to the south-easterly boundary of Block 30, Plan 3046, having a full width of 6 feet measured perpendicularly therefrom, bounded south-westerly by the south-easterly production of the south-west boundary of the said Block 30, and bounded north-easterly by the south-easterly production of the north-east boundary of the East 1/2 of Lot 2, of the said Block 30, Plan 3046, and

Secondly: All that portion of the said Monroe Avenue lying adjacent to the north-westerly boundary of Block 29, Plan 3046, having a full width of 6 feet measured perpendicularly theefrom, bounded southwesterly by the northwesterly production of the

south-west boundary of Block 29, Plan 3046, and bounded north-easterly by the north-westerly production of the north-east boundary of the East 1/2 of Lot 15, of the said Block 29, Plan 3046.

The herein-described portions are shown outlined in red on the explanatory plan certified correct by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S. on the 19th day of September, 1969, a copy of which is hereto annexed,

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portion and vest title thereto in The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
