

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5638

A BY-LAW to Acquire Certain Lands for Highway
Purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District
of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 7, 1969".
2. The Corporation of the District of Burnaby By-Law Number 5616, being Burnaby Road Acquisition and Dedication By-law No. 6, 1969 is hereby repealed.
3. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in Lot A, District Lot Seventy-two (72), Group One (1), Plan 15514, New Westminster District, and which may be described more particularly as follows:

All that part of the said Lot A lying southerly of a line parallel to, and 20.00 feet perpendicularly distant from, the southerly boundary of the said Lot A, and being adjacent to Moscrop Street, as shown outlined in red on plan prepared by B.S. Berting, B.C.L.S. and dated the 20th day of October, 1969.

The herein-described portion contains by calculation 14768 square feet, be the same more or less.

4. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
