THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 5656

A BY-LAW to Acquire Certain Lands for Highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISI-TION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1970".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), Block Twenty (20), District Lot Twenty-nine (29), Plan 3035, New Westminster District, and which may be described more particularly as follows:-

Firstly: The southwesterly ten feet of Lot 11 of said Block 20, and containing by calculation 501 square feet, more or less.

Secondly: The southwesterly ten feet of Lot 12 of said Block 20, and containing by calculation 501 square feet, more or less, as shown outlined in red on Reference Plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S. dated the 12th day of January, 1970, a copy of which is attached hereto.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
