

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5660

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5334, being the
"Burnaby Local Improvement Charges
By-Law 1968".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CHARGES
BY-LAW 1968, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1970".

2. (1) Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 5334 is amended by striking
out section 13 thereof, as enacted by By-Law No. 5546, and substituting
therefor the following:

"13. 14' or less pavement on lanes

(a) Grading and roadbed preparation on existing lanes,
asphaltic pavement not more than two inches in
thickness to a width of 14' or less, depending
upon width of lane allowances, placement of power
and telephone poles, etc.

(b) \$.257 per taxable front foot in five annual instal-
ments."

(2) Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 5334 is further amended by
adding the following as section 14:

"14. Widening to 46' and 5' curb sidewalks

(a) Grading and roadbed preparation on existing streets,
portland cement concrete curb sidewalks 5' wide on
both sides of the street, asphaltic pavement not
greater than 6" in thickness to cover existing pave-
ment to a width between curb faces of 46' including
retaining walls, storm drainage facilities and
boulevard restoration incidental thereto.

(b) \$.89 per taxable front foot in fifteen annual
instalments except that where a pavement is already
in place, for which local improvement charges are
currently being paid, the annual rate shall be \$.51."

Read a second time this 9th day of February, 1970.

Read a third time this 9th day of February, 1970.
