

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5669

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1970".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain piece, parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in Lot "X" of Lots Forty-two (42) and Fifty-eight (58), Group One (1), Plan 21473, except part subdivided by Plan 21900, New Westminster District, and which may be described more particularly as follows:

Commencing at the south-east corner of Lot 1, Plan 21900;

Thence N. 89° 36' 40" E. a distance of 236.96 feet, more or less, to the south-west corner of Lot 43, Plan 28513;

Thence S. 0° 22' 40" E. and following the westerly boundary of the said Lot 43, Plan 28513, a distance of 10.00 feet, more or less, to a point in the southerly boundary of said Lot "X";

Thence N. 89° 58' 35" W. and following the southerly boundary of said Lot "X", a distance of 237.02 feet, more or less, to a point on the southerly production of the easterly boundary of Lot 1, Plan 21900;

Thence N. 0° 00' 40" E., and following the southerly production of the easterly boundary of Lot 1, Plan 21900, a distance of 8.29 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement.

The herein-described parcel contains by calculation 2167.3 square feet, be the same more or less.

The bearings used herein are astronomic and are referred to the meridian of Plan 28513, as shown outlined in red on plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., dated the 27th day of October, 1969, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in

the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
