

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5679

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a
Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on Plan annexed hereto was established as highway by that certain plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, under number 1123.

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 3, 1970".
2. That portion of road (hereinafter called the "said portion"), being all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known as all that portion, formerly road, of Block Twenty-seven (27) of District Lot Thirty-five (35), Group One (1), New Westminster District according to the plan deposited in the Land Registry Office, at New Westminster, and numbered 1123, lying between the west boundary of Lot "A", Plan 5843, deposited, and the easterly boundary of Lot One (1), Plan 9479 deposited, and extending from the westerly production of the northerly boundary of said Lot "A" across the said lane to the Northeast corner of Lot One (1), Plan 9479 to the westerly production of the southerly boundary of said Lot "A" across the said lane to the Southeast corner of Lot One (1), Plan 9479; said portion containing thirty-four one-thousandths of an acre (0.034) as shown outlined in red on the explanatory plan certified correct by E.T. Wong, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 19th day of March, A.D., 1970, a print of which is hereunto annexed, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portion and vest title thereto in Joseph Romans and Mary Gundborg Romans, "Joint Tenants".

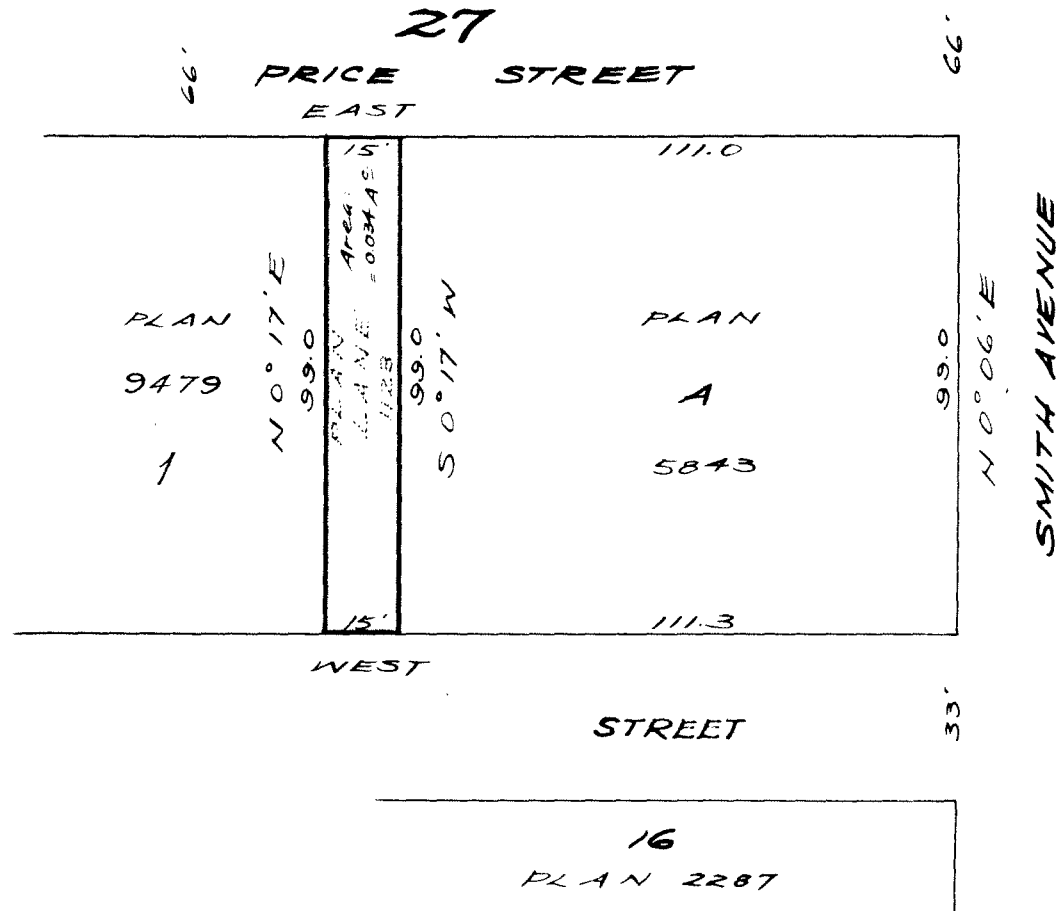
