

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5713

A BY-LAW to Abandon the Expropriation of certain real property within the Municipality for pleasure, recreation, and community uses of the public which are no longer required.

WHEREAS Council may by By-Law declare as no longer being required the land or real property or a portion thereof, which has been expropriated and may declare the expropriation to be abandoned over those portions no longer required.

AND WHEREAS certain portions of real properties expropriated by "Burnaby Expropriation By-Law No. 7, 1968" are no longer required for pleasure, recreation and community uses of the public and the Compensation money has not been paid.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION ABANDONMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1970".
2. The Council doth hereby abandon its expropriation of the North One Hundred Forty Feet (140') measured perpendicularly from the southerly boundary of Lyndhurst Street of those parcels of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and being more particularly known and described as follows:
 - (a) Lot Two (2) of Block "A", of Lot Eight (8), Group One (1), Plan 5191, New Westminster District;
 - (b) Lot One (1) of Block "A" of Lot Eight (8), Group One (1), Plan 5191, except the East One Hundred Forty-Five (145') feet thereof, New Westminster District.
 - (c) The East One Hundred Forty-five (145') Feet of Lot One (1), of Block "A", of Lot Eight (8), Group One (1), Plan

5191, except the West Seventy-two and one half ($72\frac{1}{2}$ ') feet thereof, New Westminster District;

(d) The west Seventy-two and one half ($72\frac{1}{2}$ ') feet of the East One Hundred Forty-five feet (145') of Lot One (1), Block "A", of Lot Eight (8), of Group One (1), Plan 5191, New Westminster District.

3. A certified copy of this by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, before coming into effect.
