

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5736

A BY-LAW to provide for an annual indemnity  
for the Mayor and Aldermen.

WHEREAS the Council may by by-law provide for the paying out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity to the Mayor and to the Aldermen, and the indemnity of the Mayor may be greater than for the other members of Council.

AND WHEREAS such by-law may provide that a portion of the remuneration to be made to the Mayor or to an Alderman shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY COUNCIL INDEMNITY BY-LAW 1970".
2. There shall be paid to the Mayor out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity of \$18,000.00. PROVIDED that
  - (a) the said indemnity shall be paid in twelve monthly instalments;
  - (b) in December of each year there shall be deducted from the monthly instalment due all sums paid to him as salary or expenses by any governmental body of which he may be a member by virtue of his office as Mayor;
  - (c) one-third of the annual indemnity shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.
3. There shall be paid to each Alderman out of the annual revenue an annual indemnity of \$4,000.00 and one-third of the said

annual indemnity shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of his office.

4. By-Law No. 5095 is repealed.
