

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5738

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4732, being the
"Burnaby Business Tax By-Law 1965".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BUSINESS TAX
BY-LAW 1965, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1970".

2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 4732, as enacted by By-Law
No. 5398, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"3. Save as exempted by the Municipal Act or any other
Act of the Legislature, every person carrying on
a resident business within the Municipality shall
pay to the Corporation in respect of the calendar
year ending December 31st, 1965, and annually there-
after, either an amount equal to SIX AND ONE-HALF
per centum ($6\frac{1}{2}\%$) of the annual rental value of the
real property, or part thereof, occupied or used
for the purpose of the business, or an amount equal
to SIXTY-FIVE ONE HUNDREDTHS OF ONE per centum
(0.65%) of the taxable value of personal property
used by him in or on the real property for the
purpose of the business, whichever is the greater.
Such amount shall be known as the Business Tax".

3. This By-law shall apply to the imposition of business
tax for the year 1970.

Read a second time this 13th day of July 1970.

Read a third time this 13th day of July 1970.
