

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5739

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3089, being the
"Burnaby Trades License By-Law 1950".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY TRADES LICENSE
BY-LAW 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1970".

2. By-Law No. 3089 is amended by adding the following as
subsection 33 of section 1.

"1(33) "agricultural pesticide" means any substance or
mixture of substances represented as a substance for
preventing, destroying, repelling, or mitigating any
insect, rodent, predatory animal, bacteria, fungi,
weed, nematode, or other form of plant or animal life
or virus, except viruses or bacteria on or in living
man, and includes any substance intended for use as a
plant growth regulator."

3. ByLaw No. 3089 is amended by adding the following as
14A:

"14A Before a license shall be granted to any person
for the purpose of carrying on, maintaining, owning or
operating within the Municipality the business of a
sprayer or applicator of agricultural pesticide, such
person shall at his own cost and expense obtain in an
Insurance Company authorized and licensed to carry on
business and having an office in the Province of British
Columbia, and in a policy of insurance acceptable to and
approved in writing by the Corporation, comprehensive
general liability insurance covering premises and
operations liability, including completed operations
liability. The limits of liability shall be not less
than the following:

Bodily Injury Liability	\$100,000. 100,000.	each occurrence aggregate products and/or completed operations
Property Damage Liability	\$100,000. 100,000.	each occurrence aggregate products and/or completed operations

Such person shall maintain in force such insurance as long as he carries on, maintains, owns or operates such business in the Municipality.

The liability policy shall provide that no cancellation, expiration or material change in the policy shall become effective until after thirty (30) days' notice of such cancellation, expiration or change shall have been given to the Corporation by return registered mail."
