## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5757

A BY-LAW to Acquire Certain Lands for Highway Purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 5, 1970".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in Lot Two (2), Block One Hundred Thirty-seven (137), District Lot Ninety-two (92), Group One (1), Plan 9451, New Westminster District, and which may be described more particularly as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 6, Plan 20131;

Thence S.  $89^{\circ}$  43' 00" E., and following the easterly production of the south boundary of said Lot 6, a distance of 10.00 feet, more or less, to a point in the northerly production of the west boundary of Lot "A", Explanatory Plan 15602;

Thence S. 0° 17' 00" W., and following the northerly production of the west boundary of said Lot "A", a distance of 42.94 feet, more or less, to the north-west corner of said Lot "A";

Thence N.  $89^{\circ}$  45' 00" W., and following the southerly boundary of said Lot 2, a distance of 10.00 feet;

Thence N.  $0^{\circ}$  17' 00" E., and following a line parallel to the northerly production of the west boundary of said Lot "A", a distance of 42.94 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement.

The bearings used herein are astronomic and are referred to the meridian of Plan 29026 deposited.

The herein-described parcel contains by calculation 0.010 acre, and is shown outlined red on the reference plan by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., and sworn to by him on the 4th day of August, 1970, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in

the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
