

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5770

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5096, being the  
"BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION BY-LAW 1968".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby  
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION  
BY-LAW 1968, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 3, 1970".

2. Article 3.2.2.1. is amended by adding the following as  
Article 3.2.2.1.(5):

"3.2.2.1.(5) Fire crackers means any article containing  
a combustible or explosive substance, or combination of substances,  
prepared for, capable of, or discharged for, the purpose of produc-  
ing an explosion without any pyrotechnical display, and shall include  
cannon crackers, fire crackers, mines, squibs and torpedoes."

3. Article 3.2.2.3. is amended by adding the following as  
3.2.2.3.(4):

"3.2.2.3.(4) No person shall offer for sale, expose for  
sale, advertise or display, or sell at wholesale or retail any fire  
crackers to any person or organization unless such person or organiza-  
tion is in possession of a valid permit issued by the Chief of the  
Fire Department authorizing a display of fire crackers."

4. Article 3.2.2.4. is amended by adding the following as  
3.2.2.4.(8):


"3.2.2.4.(8) No person shall use, detonate or explode  
within the Municipality fire crackers except at a place or places  
duly authorized for a display, and at such times or for such period  
of times as may be authorized under a permit issued by the Chief  
of the Fire Department."
