

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5794

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4669, being the
"Burnaby Firearm Regulation By-Law
1964".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIREARM REGULATION BY-LAW 1964, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1970".
2. Section 2 of By-Law No. 4669 is repealed.
3. Section 5 of By-Law No. 4669 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"5. Notwithstanding section 4 of this by-law

(a) peace officers acting in the execution of their duties may discharge firearms anywhere in the Municipality,

(b) any person may discharge firearms on a range approved for that purpose by Council,

(c) the Officer Commanding Burnaby Detachment R.C.M. Police may by permit in writing authorize any person properly licenced and qualified to discharge firearms anywhere in the Municipality for the purpose of destroying animals or birds which may or have become a nuisance."
