THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5814

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3102, being the "Burnaby Cab and Commercial Vehicle By-Law 1951".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CAB AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLE BY-LAW 1951, AMENDMENT BY-LAW No. 1, 1970".
- 2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 3102, as amended by By-Law No. 3463 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
 - "3. The following limitation and restriction shall apply to the licensing of the owners or operators of taxicabs. The total number of taxicabs owned or operated by such licensees shall not at any time exceed sixty until such time as the population of the Municipality of Burnaby as estimated by the Planning Director of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby exceeds the total of 120,000 people at which time licenses may be issued on the basis of one new license for every 2,000 people in excess of 120,000."
- 3. By-Law No. 3102 is amended by adding the following as 3A:
 - "3A. The granting of any license as herein provided shall be conditional upon the strict observance of this and all other By-laws applicable thereto; and it is hereby made an express condition of the granting of any license that the licensee shall observe all By-laws of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby and non-compliance with any of the provisions of said By-laws shall be deemed to be a breach of the conditions under which such license was granted, and shall render such license subject to revocation at the pleasure of the Council of the said Corporation."
