A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a portion of lane.

WHEREAS those portions of lane shown outlined red on plan annexed hereto were established as a highway by those certain plans deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, under No. 2455.

AND WHEREAS the said portions of lane are no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 1, 1971".

2. Those portions of lane being ALL AND SINGULAR that certain piece or parcel of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, being all that portion of lane as shown on Plan 2455 of District Lot One Hundred Fifty-two (152), Group One (1), New Westminster District and being more particularly described as follows:

> Commencing at the northeasterly corner of Lot Seven (7) of Block Thirty-two (32) of said Plan 2455, thence easterly 20.0 feet more or less, to the northwesterly corner of Lot "A", Block Thirty-two (32) of said Plan 2455;

Thence southerly and following the westerly boundary of said Lot "A" 229.30 feet more or less to the southwesterly corner thereof;

Thence northwesterly 22.46 feet more or less to the southeasterly corner of Lot Seven (7) aforesaid. Thence northerly and following the easterly boundary of said Lot Seven (7), 219.33 feet more or less to the point of commencement and containing 0.103 of an acre more or less;

are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon that portion of highway more particularly hereinbefore described and vest title thereto in The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
