## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5844

A BY-LAW to expropriate certain real property within the municipality for pleasure, recreation and community uses of the public.

WHEREAS Council may by by-law acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise, accept and hold any real or personal property within the municipality for pleasure, recreation, or community uses of the public.

AND WHEREAS the Council of a city, town, or district municipality may by by-law expropriate, subject to Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act, any real property for any of the aforesaid purposes.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is a district municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and in the public interest to expropriate the real property more particularly hereinafter described for pleasure, recreation and community uses of the public.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This by-law may be cited as "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1971".
- 2. The Council does hereby expropriate in fee simple, take, enter upon and use for pleasure, recreation, and community uses of the public that parcel of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8) and Nine (9), Block Four (4), District Lot Fourteen (14), Group One (1), Plan 3047, Except those portions of Lots Four (4) and Five (5) shown on Plan 5170, New Westminster District.

3. This by-law shall, before coming into effect, be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
