BY-LAW NO. 5892

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1971".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as a portion of Parcel "A" (Reference Plan 12502) of Lot Two (2), Block "F" of District Lot One Hundred Eighteen (118), Group One (1), Plan 3067, New Westminster District, which said portion is more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.



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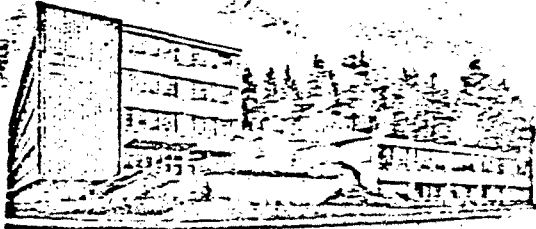

Description for Parcel Required for Widening of Still Creek Street at Smith Avenue (Link Belt Company).

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying, and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and known as all that portion of Parcel "A" (Reference Plan 12502) of Lot 2, Block "F", District Lot 118, Group 1, Plan 3067, New Westminster District, which may be described more particularly as bounded as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of said Parcel "A";

thence N 1° 05' 00" E, and following the west boundary of the said Parcel "A", a distance of 33 feet;

thence S 89° 08' 00" E, and following a line parallel to, and 33 feet perpendicularly distant from, the south boundary of the said Parcel "A", a distance of 288.93 feet, more or less, to a point in the East boundary thereof;

thence S 1° 05' 00" W, and following the East boundary of the said Parcel "A", a distance of 33 feet;

thence N 89° 08' 00" W, and following the south boundary of the said Parcel "A", a distance of 288.93 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement.

The bearings used herein are astronomic and are derived from Reference Plan 12502 deposited.

The herein-described parcel contains by calculation 0.219 acre, more or less, and is shown outlined in red on plan prepared by B.S. Berting, B.C.L.S., completed the 31st day of March, 1971, a white print of which is attached hereto.
