THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5933

A BY-LAW to adopt the capital expenditure programme of the municipality for the period from 1971 to 1976 inclusive.

WHEREAS on or before the fifteenth day of May in each year the Council shall cause to be prepared and adopted by by-law a capital expenditure programme for a period of not less than five years, showing estimates of the proposed source and application of funds for capital purposes for each year of the programme.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CAPITAL EXPENDITURE PROGRAMME BY-LAW 1971".
- 2. The Council does hereby adopt and confirm the capital expenditure programme set out in Schedule "A" annexed hereto as the capital expenditure programme of the municipality for the period from 1971 to 1976 inclusive.
