THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5936

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1971".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and known as all that portion of Lot One Hundred Eighteen (118), District Lot Thirty-Two, (32), Group One (1), Plan 34019, New Westminster District, which said portion may be described more particularly as bounded as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the said Lot 118;

Thence $S.0^{\circ}02'40''E.$, and following the west boundary of the said Lot 118, a distance of 10.00 feet;

Thence N. $45^{\circ}05'55''E$., a distance of 14.11 feet, more or less, to a point in the north boundary of Lot 118 aforesaid distant 10.00 feet from the northwest corner thereof;

Thence N.89°45'30"W. and following the north boundary of the said Lot 118, a distance of 10.00 feet to the point of commencement.

The herein-described parcel contains by calculation 50 square feet, more or less.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the

Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
