## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5948

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on plan annexed hereto was established as highway by that certain plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, under Plan Number 2297.

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 10, 1971".
- 2. That portion of road being all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and known as all that portion of Block Three (3), District Lot Ninety-One (91), Group One (1), New Westminster District, being lane dedicated by Plan 2297 deposited, which said portion may be described more particularly as bounded as follows:

Commencing at a point in the northerly boundary of Ulster Street which point is the most easterly corner of Lot 20, of the said Block 3, Plan 2297;

Thence N. 39°24'00" W, and following the northeasterly boundary of the said Lot 20, a distance of 95.70 feet, more or less, to intersection with the southeasterly boundary of Lot 18, Block 2, Plan 534;

Thence N. 50°33'00" E, and following the southeasterly boundary of the said Lot 18, and of the northeasterly production thereof, a distance of 20.00 feet, more or less, to the most northerly corner of the lane dedication;

Thence S. 39°24'00" E, and following a line parallel to and 20.00 feet perpendicularly distant from the north-easterly boundary of the said Lot 20, Plan 2297, a distance of 95.70 feet, more or less, to a point in the northerly boundary of Ulster Street, which point is the most easterly corner of the lane dedication;

Thence S.  $50^{\circ}33'00"$  W, and following the straight line joining the most easterly corner of the lane dedication to the point of commencement, a distance of 20.00 feet, more or less.

The herein-described parcel of land contains by calculation 1914 square feet, and is shown outlined in red on the by-law plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., and sworn to by him on the 21st day of July, 1971, a print of which is hereto annexed;

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portion and vest title thereto in The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
