THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5969

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on plan annexed hereto was established as highway by that certain plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, under Plan Number 1203.

AND WHEREAS the said portion of road is no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 12, 1971".
- 2. That portion of road being all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, being road known as Braemar Avenue, dedicated by Plan 1203 deposited, and comprising part of District Lot Eighty-Six (86), Group One (1), New Westminster District, and which may be described more particularly as bounded as follows:

Commencing at the most easterly corner of Lot 57, Plan 1203;

Thence S.60°14'30" E, a distance of 132.79 feet;

Thence N.51°27'10" E, a distance of 20.00 feet, more or less, to a point in the southwest boundary of Lot 256, Plan 39962, distant 125.00 feet from the most westerly corner of the said Lot 256;

Thence S.39°58'10" E, and following the southwest boundary of said Lot 256, a distance of 185.66 feet, more or less, to intersection with the northwest boundary of Lot 261, Plan 39962;

Thence S.52°20'00" W, and following the northwest boundaries of Lots 261 and 262, Plan 39962, a distance of 66.05 feet, more or less, to a point in the north-east boundary of Lot 255, Plan 39962;

Thence N.39°58'10" W, and following the northeast boundary of Lot 255, Plan 39962, and of Lot "H", Explanatory Plan 12226, a distance of 308.07 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement;

The herein-described parcel contains by calculation 0.346 acre, and is shown outlined red on the by-law plan hereto attached;

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portion and vest title thereto in The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
