THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5971

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law Number 4918, being "Burnaby Sewerage and Drainage Financing By-Law 1966".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE FINANCING BY-LAW 1966, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1971".

2. The third paragraph of the preamble of By-Law Number 4918 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable and in the public interest during 1966, 1967, 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1972 to extend, renew and improve the said systems and for that purpose to borrow during the said years a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$2,000,000.00."

3. Subsections (1) and (2) of Section 2 of By-Law Number 4918 are repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"2.(1) The Council is hereby authorized and empowered during the years 1966, 1967, 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1972 to extend, renew and improve the sewerage and drainage systems of the municipality in accordance with general plans approved by the Provincial Health Officer.

(2) The Council is further authorized and empowered during the years 1966, 1967, 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1972 to borrow for the aforesaid purpose from any person or persons, body or bodies corporate by the issue and sale of debentures in one, two or more series or by other obligations a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$2,000,000.00 repayable not later than twenty-five years from the date of the debentures or other obligations issued for the said debt or debts." 4. Section 3 of By-Law Number 4918 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"3. All debentures or other instruments issued pursuant to this by-law shall conform to the requirements of section 266 of the Municipal Act, and shall be dated not later than the 31st day of December, 1972."
