

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6079

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5858, being
"Burnaby Local Improvement Charges
By-Law 1971".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CHARGES BY-LAW 1971, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1972".
2. Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 5858 is amended by adding thereto the following as Item 18:

- "18. 28' pavements and 5' curb sidewalks with street widening to 36' as designated on a sketch plan certified by the Municipal Engineer
- (a) Grading and roadbed preparation on existing streets, portland cement concrete curb sidewalks five feet in width on both sides of the street, asphaltic pavement not more than two inches in thickness to a width between curb faces of 28' to increase to a width of 36' as shown on a sketch plan certified by the Municipal Engineer, including retaining walls, storm drainage facilities and boulevard restoration incidental thereto;
 - (b) \$.89 per taxable front foot in fifteen annual instalments except that where a pavement is already in place for which local improvement charges are currently being paid, the annual rate shall be reduced by \$.37 to the affected owners only, and where a four foot sidewalk is already in place for which local improvement charges are currently being paid the annual charge shall be reduced by a further \$.37 to the affected owners only."
