THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6112

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6052, being the "Burnaby Noise or Sound Abatement By-Law 1972".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY NOISE OR SOUND ABATEMENT BY-LAW 1972, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1972".
- Section 17 of By-Law No. 6052 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"17. No person shall operate on a highway in the Municipality a motor-vehicle with a licensed gross weight in excess of 6,000 lbs. which makes or causes noise or sound, the noise or sound level of which shall exceed 88 dBA"s in a 30 miles per hour zone, and 92 dBA's in an over 30 miles per hour zone. The noise or sound shall be measured at a distance of not less than 20 feet from the motor-vehicle exhaust pipe opening."


