A By-Law to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1972".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, being a portion of Lot Ten (10), Block Thirty (30), of District Lot Thirty-two (32), Group One (1), Plan 1848, New Westminster District, which said portion is more particularly described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto.
3. Upon registration of the said deeds in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
