

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6309

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6252, being
"Burnaby Road Closing By-Law No.
3, 1973."

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 3, 1973, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1973".

2. Section 2 of By-Law No. 6252 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore:

"2. That portion of road being all and singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being a portion of District Lots Forty-Four (44) and Seventy-Eight (78), Group 1, Plan 3049, New Westminster District, which said portion is more particularly described as that portion of road in District Lots Forty-Four (44) and Seventy-Eight (78), Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated as road by Plan 3049 and as shown outlined in red on By-Law plan prepared by R.A. Baxter, B.C.L.S. and sworn to on the 28th day of September, 1972, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic."
