BY-LAW NO. 6318

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain municipally-owned lands as a public highway.

WHEREAS the Municipality owns the lands hereinafter more particularly described.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1973."

2. All and singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as:

- (a) that portion of Lot Twenty-Six (26), Block Eight (8) of District Lot Thirty-Two (32), Group 1, Plan 1229, New Westminster District, as shown outlined in red on By-Law plan prepared by Dick F. Mak, B.C.L.S. and sworn on the 26th day of June, 1973,
- (b) that portion of Lot "A" Except the East Ten (10) Feet of Block Seven (7) of District Lot Thirty-Two (32), Group 1, Plan 13697, New Westminster District, as shown outlined in red on By-Law Plan prepared by Dick F. Mak, B.C.L.S. and sworn on the 26th day of June, 1973.

are hereby established as a public highway.
