

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6354

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 6, 1973".


2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia:

(1) Being that portion of Lot Ten (10), Block Thirty-Two (32) of the East Half of District Lot One Hundred Seventeen (117), Group 1, Plan 1222, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on by-law plan prepared by Dick F. Mak and sworn to the 19th day of September, 1973, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

(2) Being that portion of Lot Nine (9), Block Thirty-Three (33) of the East Half of District Lot One Hundred Seventeen (117), Group 1, Plan 1222, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on by-law plan prepared by Dick F. Mak and sworn to the 19th day of September, 1973, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.

Read a third time this 1st day of October, 1973.
Reconsidered and adopted this 9th day of October, 1973.
