THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 6424

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1974".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, being a portion of Lot Nine (9), Block Twenty-Two of District Lots One Hundred Fifty-Two (152) and One Hundred Fifty-Three (153), Group One (1), Plan 3741, New Westminster District, as shown outlined in red on By-Law plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, British Columbia Land Surveyor, and sworn the 31st day of December, 1973, a copy of which is attached hereto.
- 3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
