

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6495

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5096, being the "Burnaby Fire Prevention By-Law 1968".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION BY-LAW 1968, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1974".

2. Article 2.1.4.11.(3) (i) of By-Law No. 5096, as enacted by By-Law No. 5680, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"2.1.4.11.(3) (i) Without a special permit being secured, dry garden refuse only may be burned in the open air in small fires

(a) on the last Saturday of April in each year, the following day, and the following Saturday and Sunday, and

(b) on the last Saturday of October in each year, the following day, and the following Saturday and Sunday."

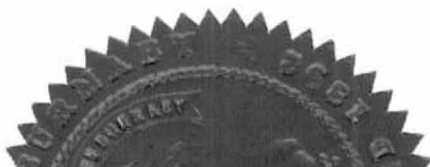
