## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 6565

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6191, being "Burnaby Dog Tax and Pound and Animal Regulation By-Law 1972"

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY DOG TAX AND POUND AND ANIMAL REGULATION BY-LAW 1972, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1974".
- 2. Clause (b) of subsection (1) of section 3 of By-Law No. 6191 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "3.(1) (b) procure the said licence upon application in writing to the Licence Inspector of the Corporation upon the form provided and upon paying the prescribed licence fee, namely:
    - (i) for each unneutered male dog....\$11.00
    - (ii) for each neutered male dog.....\$ 6.00
    - (iii) for each unspayed female dog....\$21.00
- (iv) for each spayed female dog.....\$ 6.00"
- 3. Clause (c) of subsection (1) of section 3 is renumbered as clause (d) and the following is enacted as clause (c):
  - "3.(1) (c) in the case of an applicant for a licence
    for a neutered male dog or spayed female dog,
    present a certificate in writing from a
    licenced and qualified veterinarian certifying that the said dog is neutered or spayed."
- 4. Subsection (3) of section 4 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "4. (3) The Licence Inspector of the Corporation may issue a duplicate licence tag upon being satisfied by the owner that the original licence tag issued has been lost or stolen and upon payment of a fee of \$1.00."

- 5. Section 5 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "5. (a) Every owner of a dog shall keep it on a leash while upon a highway or public place.
- (b) For a contravention of clause (a) of this section, an information may be laid and a summons issued by means of a ticket in accordance with the procedure set out in section 11A(2) to (9) of the Summary Convictions Act.
- (c) The penalty for a violation of clause (a) of section 5 shall be \$15.00 if the dog is licensed and \$30.00 if the dog is unlicensed."
- 6. Items (1) and (2) of Schedule "A" are repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(1) For each licensed dog \$ 15.00
    - (2) For each unlicensed dog \$ 30.00"
- 7. Item (2) of Schedule "B" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(2) For each horse, mule, ass,
    cattle, sheep, goat, swine \$4.00 per day or part of a day"
- 8. Schedule "C" is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

## "SCHEDULE C'

## Removal, Disposal and Cremation Fees

- (1) For each dead body of a horse, mule, ass, cattle, sheep, goat or swine \$ 50.00
- (2) For each dead body of any other animal or poultry not included in item (1), but excluding dogs or cats \$ 2.00

- (3) There shall be payable in respect of the animals or poultry described in items (1) and (2) in addition to the fee specified therein, all costs of removal and disposal;
- (4) Notwithstanding anything in this Schedule contained, licensed veterinarians and other agencies approved by Council shall pay the following fees for the disposal of animals and poultry:
  - (i) In each calendar month up to 1,000 pounds at the rate of 10€ per pound and thereafter at the rate of 7½€ per pound."
- 9. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 1975.
