## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 6599

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1974".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, being Firstly a portion of The West Half of Lot Four (4), Block Seventy-Eight (78) of Lot Thirty-Three (33), Group One (1), Plan 5074, being all that portion lying West of a straight line bisecting the North and South boundaries of said Lot 4, New Westminster District, AND Secondly a portion of the West 130 feet of Lot One (1) of Block Seventy-Eight (78) of Lot Thirty-Three (33), Group One (1), Plan 5074, New Westminster District, AND Thirdly a portion of the West 139 feet of Lot Two (2) of Block Seventy-Eight (78) of Lot Thirty-Three (33), Group One (1), Plan 5074, New Westminster District, all as shown outlined in red on By-Law plan prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., and sworn the 30th day of October, 1974, a copy of which is attached hereto.
- 3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
