BY-LAW NO. 6612

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic a Portion of Road.

WHEREAS those portions of road and lane in District Lot One Hundred Seventy-One (171), shown outlined in red on the Plan hereunto annexed, were dedicated by Plan 2686 deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia.

AND WHEREAS that portion of road shown outlined in red on the Plan hereunto annexed was dedicated by Plan 3037 and deposited in the said Land Registry Office.

AND WHEREAS the said portions of road and lane are no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 1, 1975".

2. Those portions of road and lane in District Lot One Hundred Seventy-One (171) dedicated by Plan 2686 and of road in District Lot Fifty-Three (53) dedicated by Plan 3037, all in Group One (1), New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on Plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., dated the 6th day of January, 1975, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portions and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
