THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 6650

A BY-LAW to acquire and dedicate certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1975".
- 2. (a) The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot Eleven (11), Block "F", District Lot Ninety-One (91), Group One (1), Plan 1869, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plan hereunto annexed prepared by B. S. Berting, B.C.L.S., sworn by him on the 4th day of April, 1975.
- (b) Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple at the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.

Read a first time this 21st day of April, 1975. Read a second time this 21st day of April, 1975. Read a third time this 21st day of 1975. April, Reconsidered and adopted this 28th day of April.
