BY-LAW NO. 6690

A BY-LAW to Stop Up and Close to Traffic
Portions of Highway.

WHEREAS those portions of highway in District Lot Ninety (90), shown outlined in red on the plan hereunto annexed, were dedicated by Plans 2789 and 17957 deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia,

AND WHEREAS the said portions of highway are no longer required.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 6, 1975".
2. Those portions of highway in District Lot Ninety (90) dedicated by Plans 2789 and 17957, all in Group One (1), New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on the plan annexed hereto prepared by Bryan S. Berting, B.C.L.S., certified correct on the 26th day of June, 1975, are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to abandon the said portions of highway and vest title thereto in the name of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
