

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6720

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3325, being the "Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By-Law 1953".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY WATERWORKS REGULATION BY-LAW 1953, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1975".
2. By-Law No. 3325 is amended by adding the following as Section 3A:

"3A. (1) In this section "valve" shall mean the curb-stop valve on a domestic house water service; "turn-on" shall mean the manipulation of the valve to permit a supply of water to the house; "turn-off" shall mean the manipulation of the valve to cut off the supply of water to the house.

(2) The Engineer shall

- (a) provide without charge a turn-on or turn-off between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on any working day and for the purpose of this clause "working day" shall not include Saturday or Sunday or any statutory or other holiday; and
- (b) charge \$10.00 for each turn-off or turn-on provided at any other time, but if a turn-off and turn-on are completed within one hour, the charge therefor shall be \$10.00 only."

3. By-Law No. 3325 is further amended by adding the following as Section 3B:

"3B. Any person wishing to use water from a fire hydrant shall

- (a) obtain a permit therefor from the Engineer and pay for the said permit a fee of \$25.00 for each hydrant used; and
- (b) pay for each hydrant used a deposit of \$100.00 and the said deposit shall be returned less any deductions for damage caused to the said hydrant when the use thereof is discontinued."

Read a first time this 1st day of December, 1975.



Read a second time this 1st day of December, 1975.

Read a third time this 1st day of December, 1975.

Received the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council this 2nd day of February, 1976.

Reconsidered and adopted this 9th day of February, 1976.
