

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6747

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 6253, being the
"Burnaby Bicycle Licensing By-Law
1973".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BICYCLE LICENSING
BY-LAW 1973, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1975".

2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 6253 is repealed and the following
substituted therefor:

"3. (1) Every person within the Municipality who owns a bicycle
used on a highway:

(a) shall have a valid and subsisting licence for
the said bicycle;

(b) shall procure the said licence upon application
in writing to the Licence Inspector and upon paying
therefor the prescribed fee of \$2.00;

(c) shall obtain the said licence on or before
the second day of January in each calendar
year.

(2) The said licence when issued shall be for the current
calendar year."

3. Subsection (3) of section 4 of By-Law No. 6253 is repealed
and the following substituted therefor:

"4. (3) If a licence issued with respect to any bicycle is lost,
destroyed or damaged so that same is illegible, the owner of said
bicycle shall forthwith make application to the Licence Inspector for
a new licence and shall pay the prescribed fee of \$.50."

4. Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 6253 is repealed.
5. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the first day of January, 1976.
