THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6816

A BY-LAW to provide for the indemnification of officers and employees of the Municipality in legal proceedings

The Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY INDEMNIFICATION BY-LAW, 1976".

2. The Municipality will indemnify every officer and employee against any claim for damages arising out of the performance of his duties and in addition pay legal costs incurred in any Court proceeding arising out of the claim.

3. The Municipality will not seek indemnity against any officer or employee where the action of the said officer or employee results in a claim for damages against the Municipality by a third party unless the said officer or employee has been grossly negligent or has acted contrary to the terms and conditions of his employment or to an order given to him by a person in authority over him.
