

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6854

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5096, being the "Burnaby Fire Prevention By-Law 1968".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION BY-LAW 1968, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1976".

2. Article 2.1.4.11.(3)(i) of By-Law No. 5096, as enacted by By-Law No. 6495, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"2.1.4.11.(3)(i) Without a special permit being secured, dry garden refuse only may be burned in the open air in small fires

- (a) on the last Saturday of March in each year, the following day, and the following Saturday and Sunday,
- (b) on the last Saturday of April in each year, the following day, and the following Saturday and Sunday,
- (c) on the last Saturday of October in each year, the following day, and the following Saturday and Sunday."

Read a first time this 10th day of May, 1976.

Read a second time this 10th day of May, 1976.

Read a third time this 10th day of May, 1976.

Reconsidered and adopted this 17th day of May, 1976.
