BY-LAW NO. 6889

A BY-LAW to designate Burnett House as a Heritage Building pursuant to Section 714A of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Burnett House is reputed to be one of the oldest residences in the Municipality of Burnaby.

AND WHEREAS it has been well maintained without altering its original exterior appearance and character.

AND WHEREAS the owner of the said Burnett House has requested that it be preserved as a heritage building for the education and enjoyment of present and future generations.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HERITAGE BUILDING BY-LAW 1976".
2. The Council does hereby designate Burnett House and the land upon which it is situated, namely Lot 333, District Lot 91, Group 1, Plan 51133, New Westminster District, as a heritage building and site.
