THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 6904

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 5096, being the "Burnaby Fire Prevention By-Law 1968".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

 This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIRE PREVENTION BY-LAW 1968, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 3, 1976".

2. By-Law No. 5096 is amended by adding thereto the following as Section 2.1.4.14A:

"2.1.4.14A (1) Notwithstanding anything in this by-law contained, no person shall smoke or have in his possession any lighted pipe, cigarette, cigar, or tobacco in any form

(a) in any elevator;

(b) in any retail store except in a part thereof used as a restaurant, lunch counter, hairdressing parlour, barber shop, restroom, staff offices, or rest area.

(2) In every retail store the owner or occupier thereof shall display prominently a sufficient number of "No Smoking" signs in letters not less than 2 inches in height so that the said signs shall be clearly visible from all parts of the said retail store to which this section applies.

(3) At the entrance to every retail store the owner or occupier shall display prominently a "No Smoking" sign in letters not less than 2 inches in height and so placed that the said sign shall be clearly visible to any person entering the said retail store. (4) Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with this section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine or not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$500.00."
