

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 6932

A BY-LAW to reserve for a particular municipal, or other public purpose, certain lands owned by the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Council of a city, town, district or village municipality may by by-law reserve for a particular municipal, or other public purpose, any land owned by the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FOREST GLEN PARK RESERVATION BY-LAW 1976".

2. The Council does hereby reserve for park, pleasure, recreation, or community uses of the public, those lands owned by the Municipality, more particularly described as follows:

- (a) Lots 1 to 40 inclusive of Blocks 14 and 15, District Lot 82, Group 1, Plan 2615, New Westminster District;
- (b) Block 23, District Lot 82, Group 1, Plan 201, New Westminster District; and
- (c) Block 1 of District Lots 32 and 82, Group 1, Plan 17168, New Westminster District.
